Dear Parents/Carers,

**Bus Park congestion at the end of the day**

We would like to ask for your help regarding the congestion in the Bus Park at the end of the school day.

We are one of the few schools who allow cars on site to collect children at the end of the day. We would like to continue to do this; however, the Bus Park is becoming increasingly congested with some parents parking on kerbs or in unallocated spaces and some arriving at 2.15pm in order to park up and wait for their children.

To help us, we would like to ask that you consider the following:

- Could your child walk home?
- If not, is there a possibility of lift sharing?
- Could your child cycle to school?
- Could you pick up your child at a slightly later time? We open our Bletchley Dining Hall every evening until 4.00pm where students can sit, chat, play games, do homework or have a bite to eat. This is fully staffed.
- Could they use the bus service?

Our Bus Park 'hot spot' times have eased by 3.15pm. If you do have to collect your child by car and would consider picking your child up slightly later, they would be very welcome to wait in the Bletchley Dining Hall where they will be safe, warm and dry.

Staff are out on duty to ensure the safety of our students. We ask that you please treat them with respect.

We thank you for your consideration in helping us to improve the congestion at the end of the day.
